#### **HOT WEATHER**

Those at greatest risk for heat-related illness included people 65 years of age and older, people who are overweight, people who are ill or on certain medications. Wear lightweight, light colored clothing. Light colors will reflect away some of the sun's energy. It is also a good idea to wear hats or to use an umbrella. Drink water. Carry water with you and drink continuously even if you do not feel thirsty. Avoid alcohol and caffeine, which dehydrate the body. Eat small meals and eat more often. Slow down. Avoid strenuous activity. Heat related illnesses can cause serious injury or even death, if unattended. Signs of heat related illness include: nausea, dizziness, flushed or pale skin, heavy sweating, and headaches.
